

Do we really need more IPR protection?

We examine the impact of IPR protection on economic growth in a panel of 101 countries over the period 1990-2014. The results suggest that the effect of IPR on growth depends on proximity to the world technology frontier. Contrary to previous studies we find that IPR protection is significantly negatively related to growth for countries that are relatively close to the WTF.
